

In addition to presenting Halal, Haram and Makruh of fish in the first chapter, an appendix is added to show the the same according to its geographical spot. This has been added to help those concerned specifically on fish in their geographical area.

Introduction

Praise be to God, Lord of the worlds, and may God's prayers be upon Muhammad and his family, the Imams and the Mahdi, and grant them peace

Guide to Halal Animals book consists of three chapters, the first relates to fish and marine creatures. The names of the fish have been referred to in English as well as its scientific name, with an illustration provided for the reader for easy identification. The list has been classified into halal to eat fish and haram to eat fish according to the following religious rule:

"All fish that live in water, whether in salt or fresh water, are halal to to eat if they have scales or had scales during a period of their lives. Fish that do not have scales nor had scales are haram to eat." Imam Ahmad Al-Hassan (PBUH).

There are groups of fish that do not have the usual scales that can usually be peeled but rather have bony scales attached to the skin of the fish and cannot be removed without tearing the skin of the fish, for example scales that cover cartilaginous fish bodies such as sharks and stingrays. These scales embedded in the skin and have the same structure as the teeth of vertebrates. There are other groups of fish that have scales, but only for a period of their lives, such as swordfish. There are also groups of fish that have scales, but are very small, such as eel. After listing the most important fish globally, scientific sources were researched for the type of scales or crusts covering their body and by adopting the above rule they were classified into halal to eat fish halal and haram to eat fish.

As for the second chapter, it relates to terrestrial animals. The names of the animals were referred to in English, as well as its scientific name, along with an illustration, to facilitate the identification of these animals. The list is divided into halal to eat animals, detestable (Makruh) to eat and haram to eat. The halal to eat animals include bovids, camels, and deers. These animals

are classified as ruminants, that is, they eat their food through the rumination process.

The makruh to eat animals include transport animals or riding animals, such as horses, donkeys, and mules. The third category includes animals that are haram to eat and are mainly predators, such as felines - cats, canines, pigs, and reptiles. These animals have a trait in common which is being predators, that is, they are dependent for food source on prey or smaller animals.

The third chapter of the book relates to birds. The names of the birds have been referred to in English as well as its scientific name, with an illustration provided for the reader for easy identification. The list has been classified into halal to eat bird, makruh to eat and haram to eat birds according to the following religious rule:

"Every predator with talon (prey claws) is haram to eat, whether it kills the prey on its own, such as hawks and some eagles, or it feeds mainly on the carcasses of other animals like some eagles. It is permissible to eat every bird - other than predators with talons - if its flapping is more than gliding during flight or are equal during flight. If the bird glides more than flaps during the flight, then it is haram to eat. It is also permissible to eat every bird - other than predators with talons – even if it doesn't fly if it has a gizzard, crop or spurs, "Imam Ahmad Al-Hassan (PBUH)

After listing the most important birds globally, scientific sources were researched, and the above rule applied to classify the birds into the categories mentioned earlier.

The fourth chapter related to insects and was classified in the same manner as was mentioned in the classification of the three previous chapters.

Why do we eat permissible (Halal) food and avoid Haram food?

Imam Al-Ridha (PBUH), said: "Let it be known, may God have mercy on you, that God Almighty did not allow (to eat) food or drink except for those that have benefits and remedy. And did not forbid anything other than those that have harm, damage and corruption. Every beneficial (food) gives the body strength, so it is permissible. Every harmful (food) that diminishes the strength or is toxic is haram such as the toxins, carcasses, blood, pork, canines, predator birds, birds that have no crop, eggs that have equal sides, fish that has no scale. All are haram to eat unless in necessity". The Book of Fiqh Attributed to Al-Ridha, p. 254

In an answer from Imam Ahmad Al-Hassan on this topic, here's a part that is relevant:

Haram food affects the heart because it runs in the blood and most of it reaches the physical heart in the chest and the chest is the site of the soul's connection with the body. The quality food also positively affects the human heart and its connection to the kingdom of the heavens and its vision of the kingdom of the heavens, and for this reason God Almighty warned those who asked for the table of Heaven that if they disbelieve He will punish them by punishment that he punishes no one else from the worlds. ((Indeed, I will sent it down to you, but whoever disbelieves afterwards from among you then indeed will I punish him with a punishment by which I have not punished anyone among the worlds.)) Because the table from heaven is permissible (Halal) food and of high quality that influences the heart for that allows them to see the kingdom of heavens and assure their hearts with it.

That is why they themselves explained their request for the table of heaven in order to reassure their hearts. Surely, they did not mean for that to be a miracle as they have seen multiple miracles from Jesus (PBUH) and a table of heaven itself doesn't constitute a miracle that would reassure their hearts other any different from the other miracles. So, the real reason for the heart assurance was the heavenly food, the permissible (Halal) blessed and of high quality that allowed them to see the kingdom of heavens:

(([And remember] when the disciples said, "O Jesus, Son of Mary, can your Lord send down to us a table [spread with food] from the heaven? [Jesus] said," Fear Allah, if you should be believers." They said, "We wish to eat from it and let our hearts be reassured and know that you have been truthful to us and be among its witnesses." Said Jesus, the son of Mary, "O Allah, our Lord, send down to us a table [spread with food] from the heaven to be for us a festival for the first of us and the last of us and a sign from You. And provide for us, and You are the best of providers." Allah said, "Indeed, I will sent it down to you, but whoever disbelieves afterwards from among you - then indeed will I punish him with a punishment by which I have not punished anyone among the worlds.")) Quran 5:111-5:115.

The story of this book

As a result of the lack of a reference for Muslims in classifying the meat of animals, birds and fish into halal and haram with ease, I came up with the idea of creating a classification for animal meat to know its permissibility with ease. The decision was - in the beginning - that the book would be limited to the halal and haram fish and specifically fish in middle eastern countries, that are often enquired about. The reason that led me to expand the circle, it is coincidence and let us say, scientific coincidence. I find it necessary to refer to the details of this coincidence to confirm loyalty of the student to his teacher, the teacher who does not skimp on his students to place them before the axis of choice to serve the scientific research, for it to be more comprehensive and inclusive and therefore, of more value.

On one of my visits to Iraq, I met my professor, Dr. Alaa Al-Salem in the library of the Institute of Religious and Linguistic Graduate Studies Building in Najaf, to be guided by his experience one the book's axes, benefit from his notes and directions and to then seek help with possible resources.

Dr. Alaa Al-Salem asked me about the title of the book that I intend to write. I answered, "Guide to Halal fish." After a short lull, he said, what do you think if the topic of the book should be wider and more comprehensive? What about "Guide to Halal Animals"?

The idea was welcomed by me, which I did not announce at the time. Rather, I was satisfied with the valuable discussion thereafter, which were like enlightenment that I followed. I then began expanding the research to include terrestrial animals, birds, insects, as well as fish. Accordingly, three additional chapters were added to the book, including terrestrial animals, birds, and insects.

The book was reviewed and audited by mutual correspondence between me and the Institute of Graduate Studies.

Chapter One: Fish and Sea Creratures



1. Fish and Sea Creatures

In this section of the book a list of fish and sea creatures has been developed with their English and scientific name. The list has been divided to two categories,

Category one: Halal fish and sea creatures Category two: Fish and sea creatures those are, not halal to eat, Haram

Jurisprudence Introduction - Tathkia of Fish and sea creatures:

Halal to eat fish must undergo Tathkia by Islamic law to become halal for human consumption.

Fish Tathkia involves:

- The fish must be taken alive from the water, or
- The fish must be caught with a fishing tool.
- It is not a condition for the fisherman to be a Muslim.

Tathkia wouldn't be met if:

- the fish dies in water without being caught by a fishing tool.
- the fish left to die in water deliberately, like leaving it in a small pool of water till it dies.
- the fish left in the fishing tool deliberately until it dies in water.

The Tathkia requirements for other sea creatures have the same conditions as those for fish.


General Rule:

All fish live in water, whether sea water or fresh water are halal to eat if they have scale, peels or flakes during a period of their life. Otherwise they are not halal to eat, haram, if they don't have scale, peels or flake. Scale, peels or flakes are solid pieces with different shapes that grow on the skin of the fish, they my cover the entire body of the fish or just part of it.

There are species other than fish living in water are halal to eat; like shrimp and crayfish. Details will be presented later in this book.

Fish's egg, roe, of halal fish is halal to eat and the same of non halal fish is haram.

1.1. Type of scales (peels)



Type of scales (peels)

There are many types of peels that cover fish's body, these are divided to four main types:

1.1.1. Cosmoid Scales

Cosmoid scales are found only on ancient lobe-finned fishes, including some of the earliest lungfishes and in Crossopterygian, including the living coelacanth. The inner

part of the scales is made of dense lamellar bone called isopedine. These are bony scales covered by cosmoid substance.




Examples for fish that have these scales are Queensland Latmera and lungfish.



1.1.2. Placoid Scales

Placoid scales are structurally homologous with vertebrate teeth, having a central pulp cavity supplied with blood vessels, surrounded by a conical layer of dentine, all of which sits on top of a rectangular basal plate that rests on the dermis. The outermost layer is composed of vitrodentine, a largely inorganic enamel-like substance. Placoid scales are composed of two parts, the Baseline that fix the scales in the skin while the other part takes a rectangular shape with its top heading to the

back towards the tail. Placoid (pointed, tooth-shaped) scales are found in the cartilaginous fishes: sharks, rays. They are also called dermal denticles.




Some examples for the fish that have this kind of scales are the shark and rays.




1.1.3. Ganoid scales

These are small rigid plate scales covered by a shiny ganoid layer and it is characterizing kind of the river fish, these scales are aligned with each other and not overlapping.





Some examples of fish with these scales are Paddlefish, Common Sturgeon and Bichir. They are of a little kind of today freshwater fish that lived of the time of dinosaurs.




1.1.4. Leptoid Scale



These scales are known as flake, have a disc format and grow with the fish growing and forming inner circles. The resulting of this is a fish can be aged by counting the growth rings. These scales are over lapping and partially cover other scales.

Leptoid scales are found on higher-order bony fish, the outer part of these scales fan out with bony ridges while the inner part is criss-crossed with fibrous connective tissue. They are thinner and more translucent than other types of scales and lack the hardened enamel-like or dentine layers. Leptoid scales overlap in a head-to-tail configuration, like roof tiles, making them more flexible than cosmoid and ganoid scales. This arrangement allows a smoother flow of water over the body and reduces drag. There are two kinds of Leptoid scales, ctenoid scales and cycloid scales:

Chapter Two: Terrestrial Animals



2. Terrestrial Animals

This chapter consists of the list of terrestrial animals which have been divided into three main categories:

Category 1

Animals are halal to eat, that includes bovids, camels, and deer. These animals are usually ruminant animals. It is a type of animal that eats its food by ruminating process. It digests food in two steps, primary chewing and ingestion in the normal way, then ruminating semi-digested ruminant food to re-chew it and thus extract the largest possible nutritional value from food.

Animals from the camel family undergo *Tathkia* and become halal to eat whether by the slaughtering or by Nahir. The rest of the terrestrial animals undergo *Tathkia* by slaughtering and cutting the four trunks (arteries).

Category 2

Animals are Makruh to eat, Makruh, that include transport animals or animals that humans ride (such as horses, donkeys, and mules). It also includes other animals such as kangaroos and zebras.

(He created horses, mules, and donkeys for you to ride and as a means of beauty. He has also created things that you do not know) [Quran, 16:8].

Category 3

Animals are haram to eat, Haram, that include predators such as felines, cats, canines, pigs and reptiles. These animals have a trait in common which is being predators, that is, they are dependent for food source on prey or smaller animals.

Included in this category are pigs and hyenas, which are known to eat the decaying flesh of dead animals, known as carrion.

Jurisprudence Introduction: "Tathkia" of *terrestrial* animals:

Terrestrial animals which are halal to eat must possess "Tathkia" in order to become halal for human consumption.

Tathkia is either by slaughter or nahir the animal, and they are as below:

Tathkia of camels from camel's family is by nahir

The rest of the camelid's family, excluding camels, can be by slaughter or nahir them.

All the rest of halal terrestrial animals is by slaughter them.

What Nahir is:

Camel is slaughtered while standing, with the neck fastened and folded just before the camel is slaughtered, so that it will not be subjected to torture.

Stabbing The pulp (pulp is the place of the necklace from the chest). This is the area where the camel is specifically slaughtered, which is located above the camel's chest, and this area is attached to the neck, and it is called "nahar"

Nahir is done by stabbing or inserting a knife or sword into the animal's core, just below its neck, once or twice or more.

- It is not permissible to cut off his head or be slaughtered before the animal dies due to nahir.
- It is not required in nahir to cut the four arteries, but rather stab the animal and cut off some of the arteries that transport blood.
- Nothing is required in nahir other than what is mentioned above.

Regarding slaughtering, it is obligatory to cut off the four arteries, the throat, pharynx, artery and vein, that are in the neck.

- It is haram to cut the spinal cord, however, if it has been cut, the slaughtered animal, carcase, wouldn't be haram to eat

- Tathkia shall be by the hands of a Muslim, not by a machine.
- It is permissible to slaughter with a sharp iron knife. There is no problem if the knife is of an alloy that has a percentage of iron in it, as it is the case of knives in the market.

Conditions for the authenticity of Tathkia by slaughtering:

- The animal should be directed to face Qibla direction,
- Arteries of the animal shall be cut off by hand and by a Muslim
- The name of God is mentioned on the animal while slaughtering.

As well as hunting, slouter of animals shall be perform by a muslim.

Whether hunting with a rifle, hunting animal, or a sharp object, "bismillah" shall be said while hunting. However, upon the hunter arrival to the hunted animal:

- If the animal is dead upon arrival, it is halal to eat
- If the animal still alive it should be slaughtered, otherwise, it is haram to eat

Halal to eat animal, wether killed by slaughter or Nahar, blood, spleen, genitals, bladder, cartilage and spinal cord are haram to eat, while kidney is Makruh to eat. The best part of the animal to eat is from the shoulders.

Important note:

Terrestrial animals, that are haram to eat, can possess Tathkia, once Tathkia process followed. This will result on their body parts, like skin, are regarded permissible for human use.

Dogs and pigs are exception from the above and Tathkia process is not applicable on these animals.

Chapter Three: Birds



3. Birds

This chapter consists of the list of birds which have been divided into three main categories:

Category 1: halal to eat birds such as Galliformes

Category 2: Makruh to eat birds such as Crow family

Category 3: Haram to eat birds such Accipitriformes

Birds are a group of vertebrate animals with internal heat, characterized by their feathers, teeth-less beaks, high metabolism rate, quadruped heart, and light-weight skeleton.

All birds are egg layers, females lay hard-shelled eggs where the fetus grows inside and develops until it becomes ready to hatch and emerge as a bird into the worlds.

Birds are spread all over the world, including Antarctica and inhabit a variety of habitats, like natural habitats while some can survive in human-made habitats such as cities and villages.

Birds vary in shapes, colours, and sizes, from 5-centimetres Hummingbird to 2.75-meter ostrich, and from the common raven crow to the iris lorikeet.

Scientists have proven that birds are the only remaining taxa of dinosaurs, as they are their direct descendants. Birds are distinguished from most vertebrates for their ability to fly. This ability in vertebrates is shared by bats.

The most important of these birds are flightless birds such as ostriches and kiwis. Anseriformes such as ducks, geese and swans. Apodiformes such as Swifts, Treeswifts and Hummingbirds. Caprimulgiformes such as Owletnightjars. Charadriiforms such as waders, wulls and auks. Ciconiidae such as storks. Coliidae such as mousebird. Columbidae such as pigeons. Coraciiform such as kingfishers, Bee-eaters, rollers, motmots, and todies. Cuculidae such as cuckoo. Accipitriformes such as hawks, eagles, and kites. Galbulidae such as nunlet and puffbird. Galliformes such as chickens, quails, partridges, pheasants, turkeys, peafowl and grouse. Gaviiformes, pelecaniformes, Gruiformes and passeriformes.

General Rule

"Every predator with talons (prey claws) is forbidden (to eat), whether it kills the prey on its own, such as hawks and some eagles, or it feeds mainly on the carcasses of other animals like some eagles. It is permissible to eat every bird other than predators with talons - if its flapping is more than gliding during flight or are equal during flight. If the bird glides more than flaps during the flight, then it is forbidden (to eat). It is also permissible to eat every bird other than predators with talons – even if it doesn't fly if it has a gizzard, crop or spurs. As for birds' eggs, all eggs of Halal birds are Halal, and all eggs of Haram birds are Haram" Imam Ahmed Alhasan (PBUH)

Clarifications regarding the rule above

<u>Talon</u>

A talon is a claw that is curved, pointed appendage found at the end of a toe or finger, which is the main hunting tool for birds of prey (Raptors) and without them these birds cannot catch their prey. Cassowaries also have claws but are used for defense only, while the Hoatzin birds use them to climb trees

<u>Spur</u>

A spur is a bone covered in horn that grows out of an animal's body. While claws or nails grow from the toes, spurs grow on other parts of the foot.


Gizzard & Crop

Gizzard

The gizzard, also referred to as the ventriculus, gastric mill, and gigerium, is an organ found in the digestive tract of some birds. This specialized stomach constructed of thick muscular walls is used for grinding up food, often aided by particles of stone or grit.

Crop

A crop, sometimes called a croup, a craw, or ingluvies, is a thin-walled expanded portion of the alimentary tract used for the storage of food prior to digestion. This anatomical structure is found in a wide variety of birds.



Flap & Glide

Birds that flap their wings during flight more than they glide, or are equal during flight, are considered o be permitted to eat (Halal). On the other hand, birds that glide more than they flap during flight are forbidden to eat (Haram)

Jurisprudence Introduction - Tathkia of Birds:

Halal to eat birds must undergo Tathkia by Islamic law to become halal for human consumption

Birds' Tathkia involves:

- Slaughter, and
- Cutting off the four trunks (arteries)

It is not permissible to split apart the bird's head from the neck, while still alive, the bird becomes haram to eat.

Tathkia requirements for birds are the same for terrestrial animals mention in the previous chapter. It is a condition to recite "Bismillah (In the name of God)" when hunting, firing a rifle or releasing the hunting animal. If the hunter didn't recite, it is permissible to recite after firing or releasing of the hunting animal. However, if reciting has been omitted deliberately, the birds becomes haram to eat.

Whether hunting with a rifle, hunting animal, or with a sharp instrument, if the hunter recited "Bismillah (In the name of God)" and arrives to find that the bird has died, the animal is Halal to eat. If the hunter arrived to find that the bird is still alive, he must slaughter it, otherwise the bird will be haram to eat.
